

# Chreos Background Image Help and Information Sheet

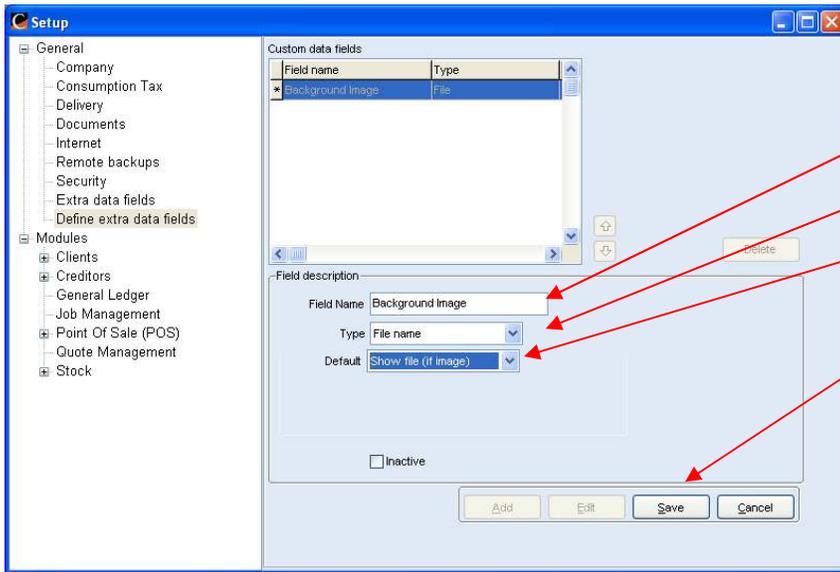


Fig 1. Define Extra Data Fields Setup Screen

To Add or Edit the background setting in Chreos go to Maintenance | Setup | Define extra data fields (Fig 1.),

## Define Extra Data Fields for Background Images

To add a background setting click [Add].  
Enter the Field name.  
Select the Type – File name is the only option for storing image data.  
The Default should be Show File.  
Click [Save].

To edit select the Field name in the grid, click [Edit] and make any changes.  
To delete, select the Field name in the grid and click [Delete].

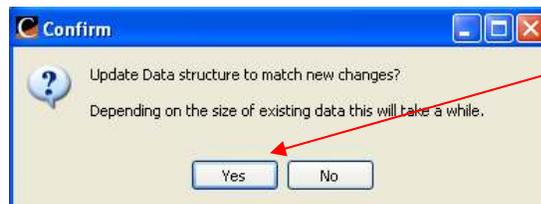


Fig 2. Confirmation Screen

After clicking [Save] a confirmation box (Fig 2.) will appear asking you to update the data.  
Click [Yes].

An information box (Fig 3.) will appear informing you that the data tables have been created.  
Click [OK].

After clicking [OK] you will be taken to the "Extra Data Fields" screen (Fig 4.) to browse for the file you want to use.

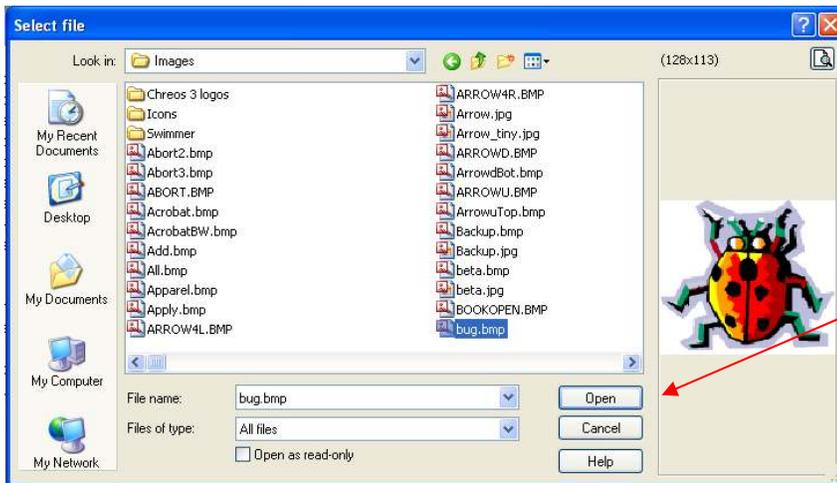
## Extra Data Fields

The "Custom extra fields" already contains "Company logo for reports" as a default.



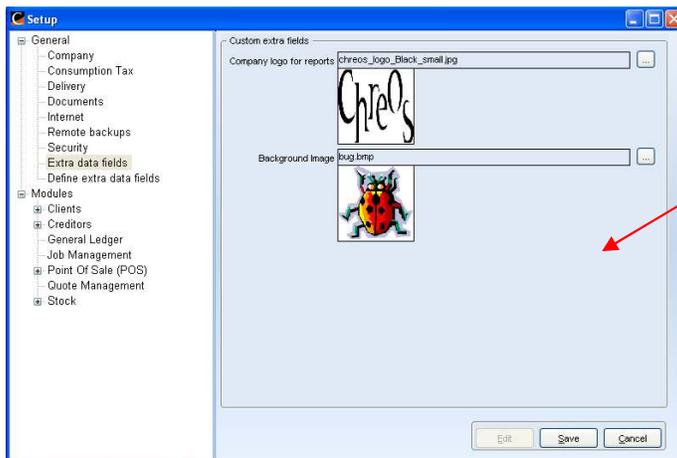
To select a background image click [...] to browse your files for the image you want to upload.

## Setting Chreos Background

To set the background image for your screen in Chreos go to Maintenance | Setup | Company (Fig 7.).
