### **Overview**

# **Details Displayed**

### **Client Details**

This panel displays the client details for the enquiry.

- Client code, Sort code & 🛃 <F3>. Select the required client. Refer to "Client search (1.3)".
- **Contact**. Select the client contact that is involved in the enquiry. To add a new contact or edit an existing contact's details, click the [...] button. Note: When the [...] button is used the 'Contacts' page of "Clients | Client management" will open and default to adding a new contact. Once you save the required details, close "Client management" and the "Client enquiries" screen will be available again.
- **Region**. Select the required region.

### **Enquiry Details**

This panel displays the number and information relating to the enquiry.

- Enquiry #. An automatically generated enquiry number.
- **Enquiry Date**. Enter the date of the enquiry. This defaults to the 'Sales date'.

- Item. If the enquiry is about a known item select the item. Refer to "Item search (1.5)". If the enquiry is about an item not yet entered into Chreos leave this blank.
- **Enquiry**. Enter the details of the enquiry. This is a narrative of what the client is looking for.

## To Add a Client Enquiry

- Select the client.
- Select the item if required.
- Enter the enquiry details.
- Click the [Save] button.
